

We started the operation of the waste, construction and demolition (WCD) recovery plant located in Girardota, Antioquia. This is a valuable solution to environmental care and reuse through the proper disposal of waste from public and private builders, and its use in recycled and certified products for reuse, contributing and strengthening the circular economy in the construction sector.


