EPM Group climbed to position 65 in the ranking of 100 Multi-Latin companies

- Currently present in six countries in the region
 - Rendering services to 20 million people
- One of the nine Colombian Multi-Latin companies

EPM Group has advanced five positions in the ranking of 100 Multi-Latin companies published yearly by the prestigious magazine América Economía reaching position 65 in the region and a Multi-Latin Index of 50.5.

The Multi-Latin Index used by América Economía magazine "measures the advancement of Latin American companies in their globalization processes along 2014", says the publication regarding the top 100 Latin American companies with sales above USD 250 million.

Four issues are taken into account when determining the Multi-Latin Index: "Commercial strength" considers the percentage of annual sales out of the country of origin and gives 25% score; "Employees abroad" with 25% score to the number of workers outside the country of origin; "Geographic coverage" related to the number of countries where the company is present with 20% score; and "Expansion" measuring geographic and commercial expansion with 30% score.

EPM's Chief Executive Officer and leader of EPM Group, Juan Esteban Calle Restrepo, highlighted the advancement achieved in the ranking of Multi-Latin companies and reminded that EPM Group's subsidiaries already account for 52% of revenues. "This is a major step in our quest for being by 2022, among the 50 first Multi-Latin companies in terms of revenue" said the CEO.





Besides EPM Group, the ranking of 100 Multi-Latin companies includes other eight Colombian companies, six of them from the Province of Antioquia. In total, there are economic groups from Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Guatemala, Mexico, Panama, Peru and Venezuela.

"We are take pride in being able to bring our business model with social responsibility and sustainability to the countries that have welcomed us in their territories where we work day by day contributing to improve the quality of life of millions of people" added Mr. Calle Restrepo.
