

The Superintendence of Companies notified resolution, stating the existence of a joint control situation between IDEA, EPM and the Government of Antioquia in Hidroituango S.A. E.S.P. and imposed EPM a fine worth COP 100 million for not having registered it. EPM will appeal said decision.

The Superintendence of Companies notified Empresas Públicas de Medellín (EPM) that the *Dirección de Supervisión de Asuntos Especiales* (Supervision Authority of Special Issues) resolved, among others, to: 1) state that there is a joint control situation in place exercised by *Instituto para el Desarrollo de Antioquia* (IDEA), EPM and the Government of Antioquia, regarding the society Hidroituango S.A. E.S.P. in accordance with the conditions of Article 260 of the Code of Commerce; and 2) impose EPM a fine worth one hundred million Colombian pesos (COP 100,000,000), due to breaching the duty of registering the control situation, according to Article 30 of Law 222/1995.

EPM notifies that the Resolution is not yet final and that it will submit a motion for reconsideration and appeal within the statutory period and legal terms.
