

Jorge Andrés Carrillo Cardoso will be the new CEO of EPM.

The EPM Board of Directors announces the following to the public opinion:

The Mayor of Medellín called for an extraordinary meeting of the Board of Directors to be held today, April 13, 2021, due to the resignation from the position of CEO submitted by Alejandro Calderón Chatet on April 12.

Following due deliberation, the Board of Directors, unanimously, recommended the Mayor the appointment of Jorge Andrés Carrillo Cardoso as CEO.

Jorge Andrés Carrillo Cardoso is a civil and environmental engineer from Universidad de los Andes and he has a Master's degree in Environmental Management from the same university. He has served as vice minister of Water and Sanitation and deputy superintendent for Water, Sewage and Waste Collection of the Superintendency of Residential Public Utilities, and he also has experience in the residential public utilities and environmental sectors.

Jorge Andrés Carrillo Cardoso has been recognized for his important contribution to EPM as current Board member, a position from which he will resign to take office as CEO of EPM.

The Mayor followed the advice of the Board of Directors and announced that his appointment will be made pursuant to his constitutional, legal and statutory powers.
