With extensive experience in the academic, public and private field, he has occupied the position of General Auditor of the Republic, Adviser of Administrative Management at the company Oleoducto of Colombia, General Secretary of the Financiera de Desarrollo Territorial (Findeter), Adviser of Bavaria for the study of the reform of state entities, Chief Executive Manager of the Group of Municipalities of the Department of Antioquia.

He has also been a guest lecturer at Georgetown University (United States) in the Colombia Programme and Legal Counsel for several entities.

Thanks to his management, he has been distinguished by the Order of Democracy Simón Bolívar in the degree of Cruz de Caballero of the House of Representatives, the Merit Medal Alfonso Palacio Ruedas from the General Audit of the Republic and the Merit Medal Don Juan Del Corral from the Medellín Council.
