



EPM opens public request for bids for construction of final civil works of the Hidroituango power plant

- Colombian and foreign companies with the technical, legal, and financial capacity may participate in the process; its presentation may be individual or associative
- The right to participate can be acquired from next Monday, April 24 until Wednesday, May 10, 2023
- The Hidroituango Power Plant already generates energy for all Colombians with its first two units

EPM opens this Monday, April 24, the public request for bids for the "*Construction of final civil works for the entry into commercial operation of Generation Units 5 to 8 of the Ituango Hydroelectric Project*".

Those who wish to acquire the right to participate in the process must pay two million pesos, which are non-refundable. Payment must be made on the Te Cuento portal, between April 24 and May 10, 2023, through electronic debit to savings or checking accounts or charged to credit cards.

The participation requirements and the conditions can be consulted on the website www.epm.com.co In the top menu of the page you must enter the "Proveedores y Contratistas" section, click on "Contracting" and then select "Consult applications Te Cuento". There you must click on "Open applications" and enter the process code **CRW256463**, corresponding to Hidroituango. Te Cuento is EPM's recruitment portal.

Legal persons, national and foreign, who wish to acquire the right to participate must comply with what is indicated in numeral 1.4 "Stages and deadlines" of the request for offers, of the "Particular Conditions".

The Hidroituango Power Plant is composed of eight generation units, with an installed capacity per unit of 300 megawatts of energy for the National Interconnected System (SIN) and at the moment it has been generating clean and renewable energy with its first two units. In total there will be 2,400 megawatts, corresponding to 17% of the energy that the country to contribute to the quality of millions of Colombians.
