



## EPM reports that

The National Environmental Licensing Authority (ANLA, for the Spanish original), through Resolution 01808 of August 24, 2022, notified on August 30, 2022, decided to declare the company Empresas Públicas de Medellín E.S.P. environmentally responsible for the sole charge formulated in Article One of Edict No. 04260 of September 26, 2017, for having impeded the contribution of the ecological flow by closing the bottom discharge valves of the Porce III Hydroelectric Power Plant, to repair the slopes of the dissipation bowl of the dam spillway or discharge of the environmental flow or bottom discharge, without a statement from the competent Environmental Authority on a minor change or normal adjustment within the normal course of the licensed activity or attainment of the Environmental License's modification (Resolution No. 0561 of May 16, 2003) established to develop the project: "Construction and Operation of the Porce III Hydroelectric Project". As a result, EPM was penalized by way of a fine amounting to SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY MILLION TWO HUNDRED NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY-SEVEN COLOMBIAN PESOS, LEGAL TENDER (COP \$760,209,687).

The necessary legal proceedings will be filed in light of the Resolution.
