



Regarding information published by the media concerning the start-up of the first two power generation units at Hidroituango, EPM would like to inform the public that:

Based on the commitments acquired with the Energy and Gas Regulatory Commission (CREG, for the Spanish original), the first two power generation units at Hidroituango should be ready to start operations before November 30, 2022.

The magnitude and complexity of the works and activities being carried out at the Project, such as installing metal shielding on the upper and vertical elbows that carry water from the reservoir to the generation units at the powerhouse, as well as the scope of the underwater works to launch the project's water intake system, and assembly and testing of all the plant's electromechanical equipment, among others, require regular reviews with audits mandated for that purpose, to the various timetables for all of the Project's fronts.

One of these audits is currently underway, and its final report should include the official schedule indicating start-up dates for the first two generation units at Hidroituango. Said schedule will be reviewed with all the specialists from the various areas mentioned above, and will become the official schedule provided to all controlling entities and stakeholders.

The Company stands by its commitment to thoroughly and promptly inform all its stakeholders, and the country in general, of any changes to the dates on the schedule for the start of operations of the first unit at Hidroituango.
