

Annex – Relevant Information

The information disseminated regarding the sanction imposed - in the first instance - on the Chief Executive Officer of EPM is confirmed. The sanction, which is not yet binding, consists of two days' detention and a fine to the sum of three monthly minimum wages, due to alleged breach of the prior ruling of the Circuito de Marinilla Civil Court, which ordered them to respond to a request for connection to the national grid for a building located in a rural area of the San Carlos municipality.

The aforementioned sanction must be reviewed in "consultation" by the superior official, who has the power to revoke it.

EPM believes that this sanction must be revoked, as they insist that they did indeed comply with the order properly and in a timely fashion.

The organization reiterates their commitment to give more homes access to public services. In the specific case of energy, in the last four years, through the "Rural Electrification" scheme, 105,612 homes in remote areas of the Department have been connected to the national grid. As such, EPM has changed the lives of almost 400,000 people. To this end, the Company has invested \$384,287 million in infrastructure.
