



EPM informs public opinion

In relation to the letter sent by the Governor of Antioquia, Luis Pérez Gutiérrez, EPM states that:

The use of the polygraph was a voluntary initiative of a group of employees and top executives, who were uncomfortable with the leaking of confidential information from the company. They wanted to be the firsts in clarifying this matter, because they are aware of their loyalty, commitments and responsibilities with EPM.

This polygraph examination was used exclusively to try to clarify the circumstances in which the leaking of confidential information occurred, which was related to a study in process and with preliminary analyzes about the permanence of the shareholding of EPM in UNE. In other words, the situation of Hidroituango has nothing to do with the polygraph examination.

The examination was practiced freely among those who had this study in their hands (18 employees).

It is false that the polygraph was used to investigate the Governor, the Comptroller and much less some journalists, as the Governor stated in his communication and in statements delivered to the media.

EPM does not use blacklists, its only lists are those that have to do with the needs of Medellín and Antioquia to seek, together with the communities, solutions to improve the quality of life.

During the 63 years of existence of EPM, we have watched as a company and institution for the improvement of the quality of life and well-being of the territories where we make presence, as a characteristic of a company that is and will remain one hundred percent public.
