EPM informs that the Ituango Hydroelectric Project's dam is in good technical conditions and there are no reasons to worry about its stability since it does not currently represent a risk for the people at the river banks, mainly downstream from the project. On the contrary, everyday better levels of safety and reliability are achieved. Furthermore, the company is successfully moving towards the general recovery of the future power plant.

On the other hand, EPM is awaiting results from the Chilean company, Skava Consulting, specialist in underground work, which will provide information about the root cause that originated the Ituango Hydroelectric Project contingency. The company is still conducting the study, which will be submitted in the next couple of weeks.

Regarding the report from the Universidad Nacional, hired by the Government of Antioquia, EPM still hasn't received it, even though it has been frequently requested.

EPM, as a company engaged with the well-being of the Colombian people and the country's development, keeps working with the contingency and to reinstate the Ituango Hydroelectric Project which will provide 17% of power to satisfy the needs of the homes, industries and businesses of the country.
